

- **January entry** for many PG programmes


- first university to have achieved a "commended" award for the **quality of student learning opportunities** from the Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education
- **£138 million investment** in campuses and IT facilities by 2018, including a new Student Centre

Why study at BU?



The Faculty of Media and Communication:

- is the **only Centre for Excellence** in Media Practice in the UK
- was awarded **The Queen's Anniversary Prize** for Higher and Further Education in 2012 for its world-leading and pioneering computer animation



- BU is home to the **National Centre for Computer Animation** whose graduates have won Oscar and BAFTA recognition for visual effects work on films such as *Inception*, *Life of Pi*, *The Hobbit*, *Avatar*, *Snow White and the Huntsman*, *Skyfall*, *Gravity*, *Interstellar*, *Ex Machina* and *Star Wars*.

- BU has been designated a **Centre of Excellence in Tourism** by the World Tourism Organisation








Why study at BUINTCOL?



- Excellence Scholarships for students with **65%** academic average or higher:
 - **£2500** reduction in BU fees for our international FC/IYO students)
 - **£3000** reduction in BU fees (for our international PM students)
- Reduction of **5%** of BU tuition fees if paid before/at enrolment







