 IELTS (Academic) 6.0 (minimum 5.5 in each component) or successful completion of the Pre-sessional English for University Study Programme for all courses; with the exception of MSc Corporate Governance which requires IELTS (Academic) 6.5 (minimum 6.0 in writing, 5.5 all other components).
